

ETNA ROSATO DOC FEUDO PIGNATONE SCIAURO 2020



Feudo Pignatone Rosè wine Sciauro comes from a selection of Nerello Mascalese grapes of Contrada Feudo Pignatone (in the district of Randazzo) on the northern side of the highest active Volcano in Europe (Etna) at about 700 meters above sea level and organically grown

The grapes destined to Feudo Pignatone rosè wine Sciauro come from plants of 30-100 years, the selection of the bunches takes place meticulously in the vineyard, so we can produce a fresh rosè wine mineral and savory, an unmistakable ambassador of its vine and terroir

Vintage 2020 climate trend: the 2020 vintage began with a relatively dry and cold winter and spring which slowed down the vegetative cycle of about one week, until June there weren't major rainy events, only in July there were abundant rains which allowed for a perfect evolution of the bunches. Very good weather in August while in September there were abundant rains and sunny days

Appellation: Etna Rosato Doc Contrada Feudo Pignatone

Grape Variety: Nerello Mascalese 100%

Vines: 30-100 years

Altitude: 700 a.s.l.

Harvesting: 13 October 2020

Yield per plant: 900gr/plant on average

Fermentation: spontaneous, carried out by yeasts naturally present in the grapes in oak casks

Vinification: the grapes, manually harvested, are pressed immediately, then the static clarification of the must and the following alcoholic fermentation in small oak casks.

Ageing: oak casks for 2 months and then in stainless steel tanks

Bottling: 7 April 2021

Number of bottles: 1.440 bottles of 750ml



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
